

## **Holkham Parish Council - Clerk's Report – 12 January 2021**

Following the last meeting, I spoke to James Bracey regarding the car park area at New Holkham. He said that he would put the required work “on the list” to be undertaken when possible.

Regarding the Boundary Commission (County Council) consultation I have submitted the text approved at the last meeting. I have received an acknowledgement but nothing else at present.

There will be a (regular 10-yearly) census day on Sunday 21 March. I'm not sure how this will operate at present and whether you will be able to express your preference for the Jedi religion or not. I'm surprised that they haven't delayed the date, and perhaps they will before we get there.

Even further ahead, there will be elections for County Councillors on Thursday 6 May plus the eagerly awaited election for the Norfolk Police and Crime Commissioner. NNDC say that they will do everything possible to make polling stations Covid-safe but they understand that people may be reluctant to turn out to vote (even more than usual). They have this week started a campaign to allow people to register a postal vote which can be either permanent or for this election alone.
